Embarkation is at Benoa harbor, Bali. The ship will leave around 9:00. After lunch you visit the traditional Bali Aga village of Tenganan (East Bali). At night, you will cross the famous "Wallace Line" on your way to Lombok. The next day you can join a land excursion to a traditional Sasak village, and weaving village as well as other highlights around West-Lombok. The ship then sails to the little known island of Satonda with its mysterious crater lake and beautiful coral gardens. The next day you will encounter the fierce Komodo dragons. A refreshing swim and some spectacular snorkeling are planned for the afternoon.

In the evening our crew will prepare a romantic beach barbecue under the stars. In Bima you will visit the local market, the Sultans palace and a traditional village where the inhabitants will demonstrate some dances and rituals followed by a ride by local horse cart around town. On our way back to Bali we will visit East Lombok with a visit to a traditional pottery village and a small village where the villagers will enthusiastically perform some local dances. Your last day aboard the Ombak Putih starts with a relaxing morning on a deserted beach at Gili Nanggu (just off the coast of South Lombok). We will leave around lunch time for the four hour sail back to Bali.

After embarkation in **Bima** and lunch on board we visit a tribal village in the forest hills outside Bima. At night we set sail to **Komodo National Park** where you will encounter the **fierce Komodo dragons**.

In **Waikelo** you will meet the **Sumbaneese** in several **traditional villages** weaving their well-know **Ikats**. During a special candle light dinner under the stars, the boat sets sail to **Flores**.

In the fishing village of **Labuhanbajo**, the villagers will demonstrate **traditional dances**. At night the crew will prepare a romantic barbeque on the beach.

Your next stop is **Bonerate**, the **second largest atoll** in the world where you can visit a small "bajou: fishermen village where villagers still make their **traditional boats**.

In the morning we arrive in **Selayar**, that used to be one of the trade centers of East Indies company (**VOC**) you visit a **fortress and other historical sights**.

Bira will be the next destination, home of the **traditional buginese schooners**. You will visit a shipyard where they still build these boats according ancient old traditions and techniques.

At night you will sail to **Makassar**. After a last refreshing swim and lunch on board you will have a transfer to the airport.

A journey back in time to animistic beliefs, colorful ikat weaving, and natural beauty!

Embarkation is at **Bima** harbor, East Sumbawa. You'll be picked up from the airport or hotel to join a city tour through this **bustling port** town to a traditional village to see some **local dances**.

The ship leaves port in the late afternoon for the **picturesque fishing village** of **Labuhanbajo**, where villagers will demonstrate traditional dances. A refreshing swim and some spectacular snorkeling are planned for the afternoon. The journey then continues south-eastwards to **Waingapu**, East Sumba, home of the intricate **ikat weaving**. We will spend a full day exploring traditional villages of East Sumba.

The boat then leaves for the remote **Sawu** island, where we will spend one and a half day to discover the animistic beliefs of the colorful locals. You will visit **ritual sites** and witness many **traditional ceremonies** exclusively performed for us. In the afternoon sailing to south **Flores**, Aimere.

From here you will start a tour to the vicinity of **Bajawa**, where you will visit a **traditional village** while enjoying the beautiful scenery. Your next stop is **Komodo National Park** where you will encounter the **fierce Komodo dragons**.

At night the crew will prepare a romantic barbecue at the beach before sailing to **Bima**. Disembarkation in Bima. Transfer to airport or hotel.
